

Bratislava: 22-storied building ought to rise up in the Petržalka shopping zone

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The Impa 22-storied multifunctional object ought to rise up in Budatínska Street, near the Bratislava Petržalka shopping zone. The building ought to be situated on currently non-enclosure grassy land, which is bordered by the access road of Panónska and Bratská Streets, the parking place of the supermarket and the car service. The multifunctional object ought to have a shape of irregular pentagon on the bottom part, and finished by semi-rounded „cube“. The hotel part involving 150 rooms from the 3rd to the 15th aboveground storey ought to be the fundament of the building. 35 flats ought to be on remaining 7 storeys. Besides reception also restaurant ought to be situated on the first aboveground storey. The second aboveground storey is allocated for offices, congress spaces involving fitness. 209 parking places in the double-storied underground garage and 62 places on the terrain ought to be a counterpart of the building.

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
