

envietech 2010: Strong impetus for environmental technology

“With an annual turnover surplus of twelve percent the environmental technology industry is one of the most dynamic growth industries in Austria. Loveridge is also president of the “National League of Cities“, the greatest American association for the promotion of towns and communities. Within his field of responsibility there is the University of Redlands, located in Riverside, which is planning the construction of a biomass power station according to the model of the town Güssing.

Dr. Pero Mičić is internationally known as a leading expert on future management. As Chairman of the FutureManagement Group AG he consults top experts from the economy, politics and administration in the field of future research and strategic implementation. Mičić is author of several books (among others “The Five Future Glasses”) and a demanded speaker at symposia, and has been, among other things, as a guest speaker to Washington, Paris, Prague, Moscow and Singapore.
