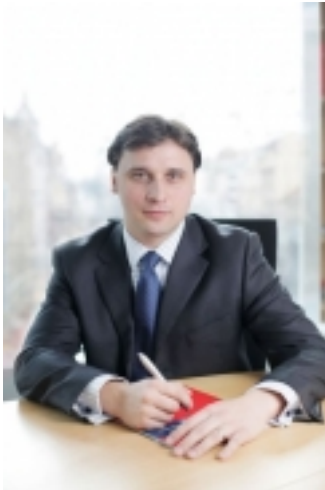


Strengthening Cushman & Wakefield retail team
