Multi-purpose complex Centrál in Bratislava to be opened in a year

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Today 65% of the multi-purpose complex Centrál in Bratislava, scheduled to open within a year, are occupied. The occupancy of offices premises is at 75%, according to the investor - Slovak company Immocap Group. The complex near Trnavske mýto comprises a 36,000 sqm 4-storey shopping centre with more than 140 shops. Centrál will offer over 19,000 sqm of office space.

Future tenants include, for example, Orange Slovensko, which will occupy an 82.5-metre office building. German company ECE, largest operator of shopping centres in Europe, will be in charge of it. The shopping centres's groundfloor and first floor will have fashion stores and services, its second floor will be reserved for catering outlets and a gym.

"Centrál is the only multi-purpose project of this size in Slovakia which obtained financing in the last three years," Martin Šramko, investment director at Immocap Group stated. A bank consortium, led by Slovak Tatrabanka and consisting of VÚB, Raiffeisenlandesbank Oberösterreich and HYPO Investmentbank, participates financially in the project.

Centrál will also include a 4-star hotel belonging to the German network Lindner Hotels & Resorts with a capacity of 230 rooms and with a congress centre for 500 guests. The project will also offer a leisure and sports centre with a swimming pool open to public. Immocap Group will offer a 6,000 sqm of park for public on the roof of the shopping centre. There will be an underground car park with the capacity of more than 1,300 parking spaces.

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
