

Main Point Karlin has obtained LEED PLATINUM

At this year's MIPIM, the award-winning office building Main Point Karlin received green certification LEED PLATINUM from the U.S. Green Building Council (USGBC). Main Point Karlin, whose investor is the insurance company Kooperativa and the contractor PSJ, was awarded LEED Platinum rating for achieving exceptional results in the areas of energy use, indoor environmental quality and innovation. These points include a unique building envelope with vertical glass-concrete pilasters serving as light shelves, cooling the building with water from the Vltava river or induction units which help the building achieve much better indoor environmental quality parameters (noise level, etc.).
