

The recreation centre Apáli will be build-up at Komárno

The Komárno town intends to build-up the recreation centre Apáli near the dead branch of the Váh River. 105-hectares are concerned, which serves for recreation of inhabitants, “like the chairman of the town office, Peter Kovács, expressed. The town proposed a motion for elaborating the planning scheme of the Apáli recreation zone at MVRR SR and it ought to co-finance 20% of it. The whole project will cost about 24 thousand Euro according to him. The recreation centre Apáli ought to be build-up during three nearest years.

The local authority at Komárno approved conception of the planning scheme of the Apáli recreation zone, at its session on January 29, which will serve as a base for the elaboration of the whole zone-planning scheme. „We are planning there a bikeway, we have entered a project for that, particular parts will be intended for canoeists, there will be treated beach and tourist paths built-up, “Kovács supplemented.

They will build-up the recreation centre near Apálsky peninsula. Presently there are private recreation cottages, forests and not treated natural covers there. There is a seat of worldwide known four Komárno canoeists. The dead branch of the Váh River is used by 35 000 inhabitants in summer like the only nearest area for recreation. In winter the dead branch serves for skating. The second recreation centre is a swimming place with thermal water and six pools in the centre of the town involving 1 500 people capacity.
